## North America's Largest Ski Resort

Nestled in the Coast Mountains of British Columbia, Whistler Blackcomb is North America's largest ski resort, offering over 8,100 acres of terrain across two iconic mountains. Connected by the record-breaking PEAK 2 PEAK Gondola, it boasts diverse runs from wide groomers to steep alpine bowls.

The pedestrian-only village is the heart of the experience, offering après-ski, shopping, and cosy cafés. It's as lively off the slopes as on them, with everything within easy reach. Whistler's family-friendly atmosphere, snow school programs, and dedicated learning areas ensure everyone can enjoy the winter magic. Unforgettable moments await both on and off the slopes.

There's something to suit every style of riding, with a wide variety of terrain ranging from beginner to expert. The resort boasts 241 marked runs, 16 alpine bowls, and 3 glaciers. Additionally, Whistler Blackcomb Snow School is recognised as one of the best ski and snowboard schools in North America.
