Tucked into the heart of British Columbia's Thompson–Okanagan region, Sun Peaks Resort is Canada's second-largest ski area and one of its best-kept secrets. From Kamloops Airport, it's a quick 45-minute shuttle ride (60 km) to Sun Peaks; from Vancouver Airport, embark on a scenic 4h 15-minute (425 km) drive to reach the mountain.

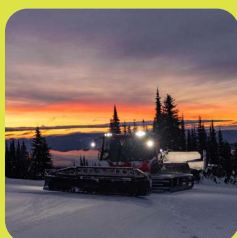
Snowmobiling Tours
