When to go:

January & February: Great snow and powder with the added benefit of less crowds.

March: Longer days with blue-bird skies and no crowds.



Fly into Calgary and take a scenic 4-hour shuttle (311 km) to Panorama. Or fly into Cranbrook, hire a car, and drive just 2 hours (161 km) to the resort.

From your door to the slopes! With most ski-in / ski-out accommodation located at the foot of the slopes, you can simply walk from your accommodation to breakfast, then to the ski lifts and hit the uncrowded slopes.



Canada's largest hot pools

Nestled just slope-side at Panorama Springs Lodge, Canada's largest slopeside hot pools offer you a year-round retreat with two hot tubs, a warm pool, and a cold plunge, all under the stars with views right onto the mountain.



Ski Terrain All to Yourself

Test your skills on uncrowded slopes with amazing 360° views, from wide open cruisers, powder-filled tree lines and bowls to chasing powder stashes. It offers vast areas of skiable terrain and a selection of chairlifts that efficiently spreads people out across the entire mountain, making it suitable for all skiing levels.

For black-diamond runs, head to Taynton Bowl, formerly a heli-skiing area, is now within bounds, patrolled, avalanche controlled and no backcountry gear is needed.





Winter Experiences

Heli-Skiing

Flying directly in/out of Panorama's Village, experience the deep powder and perfect gladed tree runs of the Purcell Mountains. Spectacular scenery, expansive glaciers and quality glade skiing offering the adventure of a lifetime!



Snowmobiling

Some of the best snowmobile tours are on offer. Depending on the tour, guides take you up through snow-laden trails amongst old growth forest to visiting an abandoned silver mine. See a spectacular frozen waterfall, and local wildlife!



Tandem Paragliding

Soar high above Panorama and take in breathtaking views of the Purcell and Rocky Mountain ranges from a vantage point usually reserved for eagles. A rare and unforgettable experience at a Canadian ski resort.



Monster X Snowcat

Not into hiking with your ski gear? Good news, this is an easier way to access monstrous terrain that boasts nine double-black diamond runs and plenty of unnamed lines in between. Best mountain shuttle service there is!



Snowshoeing

Swap your skis and board for a pair of snowshoes and take a guided tour along snow-laden tracks and trails. A great way to get outdoors and experience the beautiful forest surrounding the resort.



Mountain Hut Dining
