## North America's Largest Gladed Terrain

Kimberley Alpine Resort is a family-friendly ski destination that balances approachable terrain with serious ski experiences. With 1,800 acres of skiable terrain across 80 runs, it's best known for its wide, rolling groomers, perfect for beginners and intermediates, alongside gladed tree skiing that challenges advanced riders.

The purpose-built village keeps everything convenient, while the nearby town of Kimberley adds extra charm with its Bavarian-inspired architecture, cafés, and breweries.
